3/ What to include in the AGM – Paddler of the year / Finance / Reports from the disciplines. Written questions and proposals from members and verbal questions on the day.

Action Point: KS to prepare POTY pages and send them out for voting by club members.

4/ The use of "What's App Groups", Facebook groups and other social media. Main issue – how do we ensure that these do NOT become cliques or sub-groups, how do you ensure that these are only available to members? Who runs and maintains them? Action point: TBC at next meeting – ongoing clarification and refining of what is a club trip

Proposal/clarification from KS – Google groups is the only media that includes all members. A trip can only be called a club trip (with 3^{rd} Party liability and use of club boats) if it has been approved and appears on the club calendar.

We have a process of vetting and approving any new trip or venue before it goes on the calendar – send an email to <u>calendar@liverpoolcanoeclub.co.uk</u> If members use any other media (including the google group) to arrange to paddle, then this is fine but it must be very clear that this is NOT a club trip – it is a leaderless or peer trip. THE CLUB <u>ONLY</u> DOES LED TRIPS AND PADDLES. We try NOT to use the word "Peer".







5/ Follow up on the move of club bank approved at last Stewardship Meeting – we are now with Metro Bank – Business Community Accounts and is totally free for the club to use. Craig Ford and Keith Steer are key signatories.

6/ Do we need to continue with 'Bookwhen' for regular or even casual dock paddles?

Clear consensus that yes, all paddling needs to be pre-booked using either bookwhen or email to ensure the correct ratio of paddler to leaders – see point 4 above. It was thought to be a massive move forward with lots of new leaders taking responsibility for small groups.
